FAITH TALK

1 Samuel 18–20: "David and Jonathan"

Here are some ways to nurture faith at home based on this week's story.

(1) Read 1 Samuel 20:13. Jonathan chose to protect his friend even though it would make his father angry. What do you think helped Jonathan tell the truth?

(2) Act out the escape scene in 1 Samuel 19:12–14 using only a chair or bench

(3) Draw a picture of you and a friend. What makes that person such a good friend? Did you know? The name Jonathan means "gift of God." The name David means "beloved."
