Book of Esther: "Queen Esther"

- (2) Is there any issue of justice today about which you feel particularly called to speak out? (3) Make a crown with a star on it to remember Esther's bravery.

Did you know? The book of Esther is read aloud at the Jewish feast of Purim. As it is read,

people make loud noise so that the name cannot be heard. (Haman)
