FAITH TALK

Mark 10:17-31: "The Rich Man"

Here are some ways to nurture faith at home based on this week's story.

- (1) Read Mark 10:17-22. I wonder why Jesus asked the man to give up everything he owned.
- (2) Some choices are harder than others. Ask "would you rather" questions. For example: "Would you rather eat ice cream or play games?"
- (3) Jesus compared rich people entering God's kingdom to camels going through a needle's eye. Practice threading needles. Even that can be hard.

Do you know? Who tamed camels before 2000 BCE?

(The people of ancient Somalia.)

Prayer for the week: *God, help us to spend more time caring for people than worrying about things we have or want. Amen.*
